The Center for Japanese Studies (CJS), UHM, is offering a scholarship for a UHM student to participate in the [75th Japan-America Student Conference \(JASC\)](#), July 30 – August 2, 2023 (required orientation in Los Angeles) and August 2 – 26, 2023 (JASC conference in Tokyo, Kyoto, and Nagasaki).**

The Scholarship is in the amount of \$3500 (cost of JASC participation fee)

[*Participation fee does not include the roundtrip airfare from Honolulu to the JASC orientation site in Los Angeles. Student is responsible for covering the round-trip airfare expense and other personal expenses.]

Requirements for the Scholarship:

1. UHM classified full-time undergraduate or graduate student status at the time of application and during the conference
2. Evidence of high academic achievement and promise
3. Acceptance letter to participate in JASC

Submit a screenshot of the full JASC application by email to the Center for Japanese Studies (gay@hawaii.edu) by December 31, 2022.

Students must submit their applications directly to JASC by the deadline December 24, 2022, with a non-refundable application fee of \$20 to qualify to participate in the conference.
